# GREAT VICTORY BY LINWOOD 1!

## *Sang Yong Park leads team to great win...*

On paper, Kirwee 1 looked strong enough to continue their winning ways, and once Simon Wallace and John Cordue had taken the first two matches, including Cordue’s win over previously unbeaten David Walle, the Kirwee side looked on track.

However, Linwood 1 were just about to start their assault. Daniel Jefferies and David Walle combined to take the first of the crucial doubles matches, then Sang Yong Park entered the contest and defeated Kris Alisch in a hard fought four game battle.

Cordue maintained his unbeaten record by beating Jefferies in straight games, but that was the last match Kirwee 1 were able to secure. Walle and Park fronted Cordue and Wallace in the second doubles, and the pair completed a second doubles win of the night for the Linwood team. This put Linwood in a good position to achieve at least a draw, as Walle, who has been in such strong form, was likely to be victorious in the final match of the night. This meant that the penultimate match, comprising of Park and Wallace, provided Linwood the chance of what might be considered a slight upset. Park started strongly and took the first two games, then Wallace started to find his rhythm and levelled the match at two games all. However it was Park who looked more comfortable in the final set, and despite the game going to 10-all, it was an elated Park who showed great skill and commitment in the final points to secure the win.

Jesse Wilson, Vladimir Ivanov and Hongyi Li all contributed one singles win each in what was a real team effort in securing an important win against Kirwee 2. Kirwee 2 had their chances, and Simon Fenwick took his well as he completed 2 good singles wins for his team.

However the Harewood team also combined well in winning both doubles, and as is so often the case, that was pivotal in the contest outcome. The final result was 5-3 to Harewood, keeping them well in contention for the top spots in the first round of Super Club.

### *All to play for...*

Tonight is the final contest of Round 1, and there is all to play for for many of the teams. The top three teams on the leader board are all on six competition points, and only one match win separates both 1st and 2nd, and 2nd and 3rd.

Kirwee 1 sit on top and are expected to come through tonight with a win against Lincoln Uni. Hans Moreels makes his first appearance and will compete against Jim Chen and Paul Wang, also making his first appearance.

Harewood are also expected to come through with a win against Linwood 2, with Grant Wilson another making his first appearance. There are some intriguing match ups with Griffin Buchanan playing both Jesse Wilson and Vladimir Ivanov.

For Kirwee 1 and Harewood tonight is not just about collecting the points for winning. Both teams need to win as well as they can, as the countback of individual match wins will likely be critical in determining final positions.

Linwood 2 are in 3rd position on the table, and they are up against Kirwee 2 in what will probably provide some of the best matches of the night. David Walle and Sang-Yong Park (Linwood), and Simon Fenwick and Jafaar Moussa (Kirwee) have all been in good form. Linwood 1 can threaten 1st and 2nd position if they were to win well enough, but alternately could finish as low as 4th. Kirwee 2 on the other hand are probably playing for 3rd or 4th position.
